

2D GENDER DETERMINATION ULTRASOUNDS

When:

This ultrasound can be performed after you have had a 20 week screening ultrasound, if gender cannot be determined at that point.

Scan Time:

A gender ultrasound consists of 10 to 15 minutes of scanning time.

Pictures:

You will receive additional pictures of your baby at this appointment.

Payment:

Gender ultrasounds are \$90.00. This is not covered by insurance.

Refunds:

There are NO refunds. However, if we are not able to see the gender you will be granted one additional follow up scan.

Fetal Position:

There are times when babies are positioned in a way we are unable to accurately see the baby's gender.

Accuracy of Gender:

It is important to understand that even with the highest level of ultrasound and machine, it is impossible to say with 100% certainty the gender of your baby.

Guests:

You are welcome to bring guests (no more than three) to the ultrasound room.

OUR ULTRASOUND MACHINES OFFER STATE OF THE ART 3D/4D IMAGING OF YOUR BABY.

Your ultrasound will be performed by one of our experienced and caring registered diagnostic medical sonographers.

In order for the sonographer to be able to acquire the best 3D/4D image, it is preferred that you be at least 28 weeks along in your pregnancy. If you are under 28 weeks, the images will not be as ideal.

We cannot 100% guarantee perfect images of each baby. The most important thing to remember is that in order to get a good 3D picture of your baby, the baby must be in a good position and have an adequate amount of surrounding amniotic fluid. If your baby is not positioned well we will still do our best to get a good picture for you.

We do not recommend 3D/4D ultrasounds for women who are pregnant with twins.

3D/4D ultrasounds look the same on the monitor. 3D refers to the still image/picture of your baby. 4D is seeing your baby moving on the screen.

Requirements:

To schedule an elective 3D/4D ultrasound or 2D gender determination ultrasound you must meet the following conditions:

- Must be a current patient of The Group.
- Must have already had a complete Level I or Level II ultrasound as ordered by our physicians or midwives. (These are normally performed at 20 weeks.) For patients transferred into our office this will be determined by your provider.
